

raw-cut bramble timbers, burnt paper-cache cinders, heat-scoring esse into tongue.





WARNINGS


There are emergency vehicle sirens in parts of Doctor Pressure.

It's always about tension, resistance, release. The limits of utility. The limits of malleability. I need to escape myself, And to hold myself, And to be held.






